P.T. Usha becomes first woman Indian Olympic Association president.



On December 10, 2022, the legendary P.T. Usha was elected as the first woman president of the Indian Olympic Association (IOA), ushering in a new era of the country's sports administration.

The IOA was warned of a possible suspension by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) if elections were not held in December 2022 as the polls were due to be held since December 2021. Usha, who had joined the Rajya Sabha backed by the Bharatiya Janta Party (BJP) emerged as the lone candidate for the top post. Nobody was willing to fight against Ms. Usha fondly known as the 'Payyoli Express'.

Avatar: The Way Of Water led the domestic weekend box office charts for the fourth consecutive time with an estimated \$45 million in earnings between Friday and Sunday, according to Box Office Mojo, as the movie's worldwide revenue surpasses \$1.7 billion and inches towards director James Cameron's \$2 billion target—making it one of the most lucrative films of all time.

Disney's Avatar: The Way Of Water—Cameron's sequel to the highest-grossing film of all time—has earned a total of \$516.8 million domestically along with \$1.19 billion in international earnings, making it the seventh highest-grossing film of all time.

According to a 2016 People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA) report, over 250 cosmetics brands still test their products on animals, affecting Royal Society for the what the of Cruelty to Animals Prevention (RSPCA) estimates to be over 27.000 animals each year. In 2013 India banned the import of animal-tested beauty products, both on its soil and imported goods, becoming the first cruelty-free South cosmetics in Asia. zone

The Humane Society says that even though animal testing is not required by law (like it is in China), companies still choose to use it. The animals most frequently used are mice, rats, rabbits, and guinea pigs. Unfortunately, these animals are often not protected under the Animal Welfare Act. A solution to animal testing is for companies to use already deemed safe products. Many ingredients have been deemed safe for human skin, and if we stick to using those, there will be no need for animal testing.

According to PETA, an alternative to animal testing that companies use is to use cornea-like 3D structures, which are produced from human cells. These human skin cultures can be grown and purchased specifically for cosmetic testing. If a humanitarian and conscious way of living is your new year's resolution (we hope it is)

Recipe: winter Protein scramble:

2 eggs Spinach leaves 1 cup Bell peppers 1/2 cup Tomato 1/2 cup Ghee 1 tsp Green garlic or corriander leaves 2 tbsp. White sesame seeds 1 tsp

Method:

1. Roast sesame seeds in ghee

2. Add all veggies and stir for 1-2 minutes

3. Add eggs and switch off the flame, and mix well to have a soft textured nutrients rice scrambled eggs.

Garnish with green garlic or corriander leaves

Eat this with 1 raagi flour's roti on side as lunch or as dinner.

Rich in protein, calcium and fiber. Low in fat.

PERSONALITY OF THE MONTH

Dr BR Ambedkar

We all know Dr Ambedkar as the emancipator of Dalits as the man who laid down his life for the welfare of his community. Born into the Mahar (Dalit) caste, he knew better than anyone the struggles his community faced while trying to find its place in modern India. He was strongly against the Brahmanical varna (caste) system, so he envisioned a place for the 'untouchables' in independent India. Through his relentless effort, he created reservations for his

community in educational and government systems.

As the Constitution Drafting Committee chairman, Dr Ambedkar played a pivotal role in shaping various civil liberties our citizens enjoy today. Having studied the constitution of around 60 countries, he was a wise expert, and no one could have done a better job than he did then. We all know him as 'the father of India's constitution'. Let's take a look at some of his lesser-known achievements, mainly the literary ones.

Dr Ambedkar came up with the slogan "educate - agitate - organise". He spent a good amount of time educating the Dalit community and making them aware. In his lifetime Babasaheb Ambedkar wrote around 23 books, some of which were published when he was still alive and others after his death. He was the editor and publisher of various newsletters and magazines, which he started to spread a wave of consciousness among the Dalit community. His literary accomplishments have had a huge impact in mobilising the Dalit community to rally for their cause.

Let's look at some of his publications and their agendas -

1. Moon Nayak was the voice of the voiceless – Dalits. It served to agitate and inform the masses. It was published in Marathi. He chose to publish in Marathi despite mastering the English language because all the Dalits couldn't read and understand English.

2. Bahishkrit Bharat was another Marathi fortnightly that talked about the pains and problems of the untouchables. Ambedkar also used it to answer his critics. This publication played a seminal role in awakening the Dalits.





Indian doctorate student selected for Paris 2024 taekwondo referee camp



World Taekwondo has selected Dipshikha Baruah, who is currently pursuing her doctorate in physical education from Lovely Professional University. Baruah is a black belt 3rd Dan and is also an international referee. The Paris 2024 Olympic Games International Referee Selection and Training Camp for Asia and Oceania is set to be held from February 12 to 14 in Tashkent in Uzbekistan, according to The Tribune.

The Pan-American camp is planned to be held in Mexico, while Belgium will host the one for Europe and Africa. The camp in Uzbekistan is expected to see 100 referee trainees. The taekwondo at Paris 2024 is scheduled to be held from August 7 to 10.

Taekwondo made its Olympic debut as a demonstration sport in Seoul in 1988. It was once again introduced as a demonstration event in Barcelona in 1992. It has appeared as a full medal sport since Sydney 2000 and has appeared in every edition since then.

Baruah is a World Taekwondo Level 2 coach. She is also the first female from her native place Assam in India, to become an International Referee of Taekwondo. She is also a yoga expert and a freelance model.

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


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
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
